



BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICE

In Clark County, a unique coordinated partnership creates a Single Room Occupancy (SRO) Facility at Vancouver VA Medical Center.



A Single Room Occupancy (SRO) facility in Clark County became possible through a first of its kind coordinated partnership between the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), The Vancouver Housing Authority (VHA) and Clark County Department of Community Services. The VA leases the land to VHA at no cost on an “enhanced use lease” basis in exchange for half of the SRO rooms being available exclusively for veterans. Funding for the project came from several sources including U.S. Dept of Housing and Urban Development – McKinney and HOME funds; a grant from the Washington State Housing Trust Fund; and, the Clark County Veterans Assistance Fund.

Located on the campus of the Vancouver VA Medical Center, the SRO has been open since the summer of 1999.

ENTRANCE CRITERIA:

1. Veteran status
2. Homeless or at risk of homelessness
3. Verifiable income (must be less than \$20,000/year)
4. Must be clean and sober for 30 days and committed to a clean and sober lifestyle
5. Capable of living independently
6. Must have a case manager
